# Broadcasting To The World From Ballyfermot in Ireland-Year 5!

For the fifth year in a row, WWCR is working with Ballyfermot College in Ireland, to broadcast their programs on International Shortwave Radio.

Students from [Ballyfermot College of Further Education](#), will broadcast to the world on their own radio station, Emerald Radio, between Monday, April 30th and Friday, May 4th, 2001. Programs will be relayed from Dublin live via phone lines to WWCR, in Nashville, Tennessee, USA. These broadcasts will be at 11:00AM-Irish Time, 1000 UTC. At the same time, programs will be broadcast on the student's own web site: [www.emeraldradio.com](http://www.emeraldradio.com).

Emerald Radio is a project undertaken by second year radio and journalism students at Ballyfermot College of Further Education. All production, presentation and research is undertaken by students as are the financing and the management of the station. Emerald Radio programs will be broadcast on the following schedule:
